We bring together scholars and cultural practitioners, civil society projects, schools, museums, theaters and memorial sites to take a critical and forward-thinking look at the production and reflection of images of and about migration from the perspective of different disciplines. This exchange will address the following questions:

- (a) How can contributors in the above-mentioned fields learn from each other when it comes to the use of images (photos, films, videos, drawings) in the process of generating knowledge about migration, integration and related diversity?
- (b) How can educational, social and cultural sciences learn from each other with regard to the use of images in the dissemination of research results on the topic of migration?
- (c) How can academia, civil society and culture work together to create new images of migration?
